## **Eligibility:**

To be eligible, an applicant must

- be a current high school freshman or sophomore;
- permanently reside within Aurora, Brule, Buffalo, Jerauld, Sanborn, Miner, Davison, or Hanson counties of South Dakota or be the dependent of a Central Electric member;
- Have an interest in furthering your knowledge about cooperatives, your strengths and leadership skills, and be ready to participate with an open mind!

Applicants will be sent a "Student and Parent Consent Form" to complete the application process. One student from each county or director district may be selected.

## **Program Details & Commitments:**

The program will consist of three sessions:

- 1) One-day leadership session #1 (May 2019) in Mitchell, SD or central location. Leadership sessions will include team-building activities, guest speakers, and more.
- 2) SDREA Youth Excursion (July 22-25, 2019) in Bismarck, ND. Students will travel to North Dakota and tour the Great Plains Synfuels Plant, the Freedom Coal Mine and Antelope Valley Station electric power plant. Evenings will be spent swimming, dancing and shopping with new friends from other rural electric cooperatives across the state.
- 3) One-day leadership session #2 (August 2019) in Mitchell, SD or central location.

There is no cost to the student to participate other than transportation to the local sessions (transportation and costs for Youth Excursion are provided).
