



Jay Headley Memorial Scholarship

How much is the Scholarship?

The family of Jay Headley will award two scholarships in the amount of \$1000 each. The scholarship must be used for educational costs, and the student must enter an accredited two year or four year college, university or vocational/technical school in the fall of the school year for which the scholarship is given.

The scholarship check will be made payable to the school, and will be distributed by Central Electric Cooperative. The scholarship is funded by the family of Jay Headley.

Who is eligible to receive the Scholarship?

Dependent children of Central Electric Cooperative members who are pursuing a bachelor's of science degree in an agricultural related field are eligible for this Scholarship. The applicant's primary residence must receive electric service from Central Electric cooperative and the applicant must be a U.S. citizen.

The scholarship will not be awarded to the same recipient of the Basin Electric Power Cooperative Scholarship; however, it will be awarded without regard to other awards, loans, or financial assistance the applicant may have obtained.

Children of Central Electric Employees or Board Members and previous winners of this scholarship are not eligible to apply.

How is the recipient selected?

The award is based on SAT/ACT scores, grade point average, work experience, participation in school and community activities, a statement by the student explaining his/her educational and career goals, and a written recommendation by a third party. A representative of Central Electric Cooperative will be responsible to select the recipient to be awarded a scholarship.

What are the recipient's obligations?

Except for the requirements outlined in this brochure, no obligations will be imposed upon the student as a scholarship recipient. Other than payment of the scholarship, no obligations or liability are assumed by Central Electric Cooperative or the family of Jay Headley.

How Can I Apply?

Application forms can be obtained from the website www.centralec.coop or by calling 1-605-996-7516 or 1-800-477-2892. Applications must be returned by February 1 or they will not be considered.

Scholarship Submittal Requirements

1. Complete the application form by typing or printing (attach additional sheets if necessary).
2. Enclose your most recent academic transcript whether it is from a high school, college, university or trade school.
Current College Freshmen – Judges will screen and require more than one semester or quarter of grades.
If this applies to you, submit your high school transcript.
3. Enclose a copy of your college entrance examination (ACT and/or SAT) scores.
4. Enclose the applicant appraisal.
