POLICY 804

ELECTRIC HEAT WITH CONTROLLED A/C & WATER HEATING

I. Type of Service

Single and three phase service at available secondary voltages.

II. Availability

Available to consumers that have single and three phase farm, residential, seasonal and commercial services for separately metered heating, controlled water heating, and controlled air conditioning purposes. This rate applies to electric heating installations reported as Uncontrolled Electric Heat as of December 31, 2002 and all electric heating systems installed since then.

III. Special Conditions

- A. The rate shall be applicable for the billing periods of January – December until the heat rate is rescinded by Basin Electric.
- B. The electric heating equipment must be a permanent electric resistance heating system, rated at 208 volts or more, totaling 8,000 watts (per electric panel) and/or heat pump system in a residence or commercial building.
- C. The cooperative will provide the meter, socket, current transformers and load management receiver.
 - 1) A non-refundable service fee of thirty dollars (\$30.00) will be required for installation.
 - 2) Non-standard or non-residential installations may be required to reimburse the cooperative for labor and wiring materials for installation of the meter.
- D. Consumers with a qualified electric heat system and a service of 50-250 KVA or of installed transformer capacity may be subject to kw demand charges per the following:
 - 1) If the 50-250 KVA or greater of installed transformer capacity is a result of the electric heat the consumer will not be subject to the kw demand charge.
 - 2) If the 50-250 KVA or greater of installed transformer capacity is not a result of the electric heat the consumer will be billed their normal kw demand less the electric heat kw demand.
- E. Members with a qualified electric heat system and a service of over 50 KVA of installed transformer capacity may receive this rate through a separately metered electric service provided by the member and dedicated to the electric heating equipment.
- F. Meters on electric heating equipment that have not registered kwh's for 18 consecutive months may be removed at the discretion of the cooperative.

IV. Rate

A. Facility Charge

1) In accordance with the applicable rate schedule for the class of service.

B. Energy Charges per month

1) All kwh's recorded on the separate sub meter @ \$.056

C. Minimum Charge

1) In accordance with the applicable rate schedule for the class of service.
